We have also expanded our mental health services. Following integration of mental health into medical care services, we have already seen improvement in common chronic metabolic conditions such as diabetes.

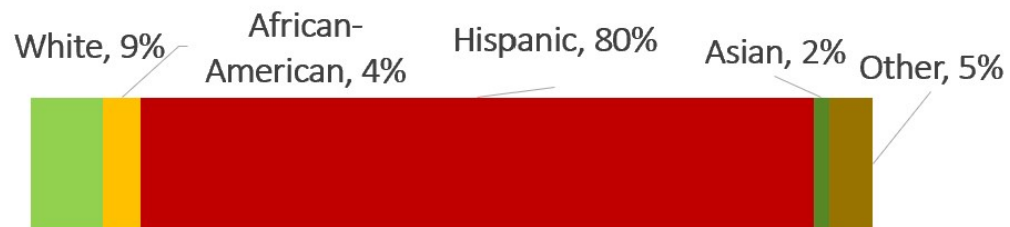

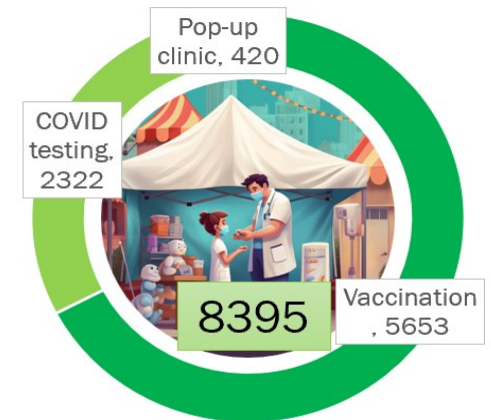

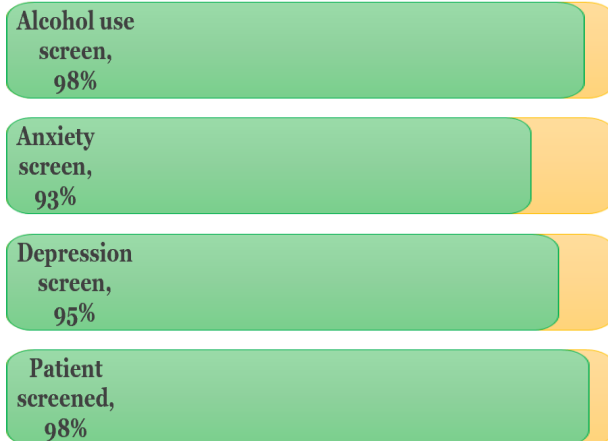


MEASURE OF EFFECTIVENESS IN SEEING OUR MISSION COME TRUE

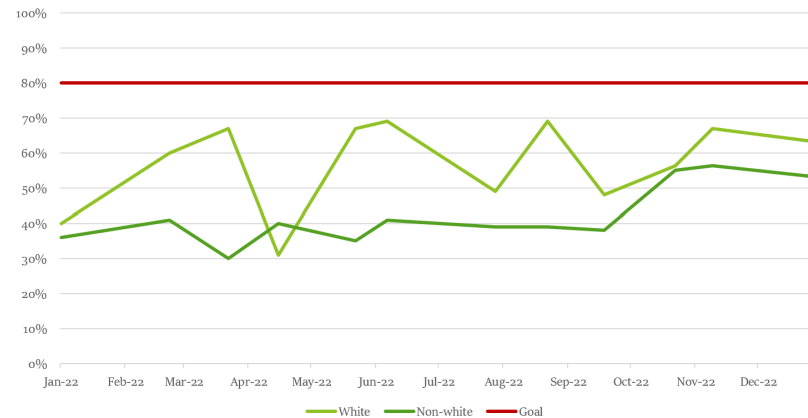
Our Mission is “is to *Provide multicultural care to elders, promote aging in place, support life’s changes, and enhance enjoyment.*”

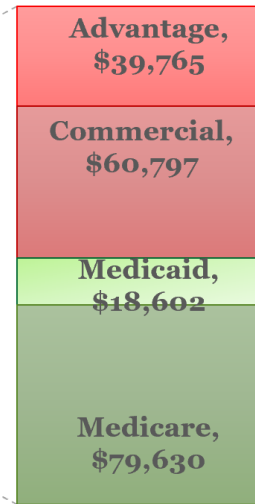
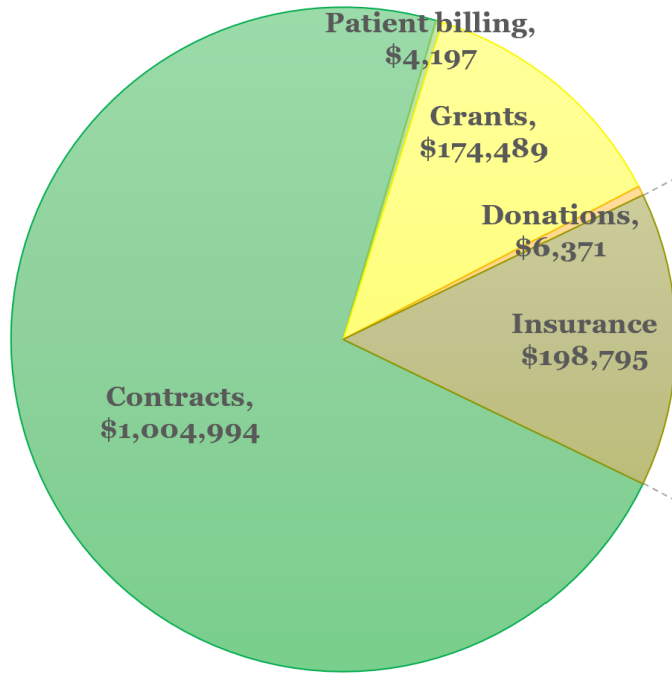
Integrated Mental Health Outcomes



Reduction of Disparities in Advance Directives

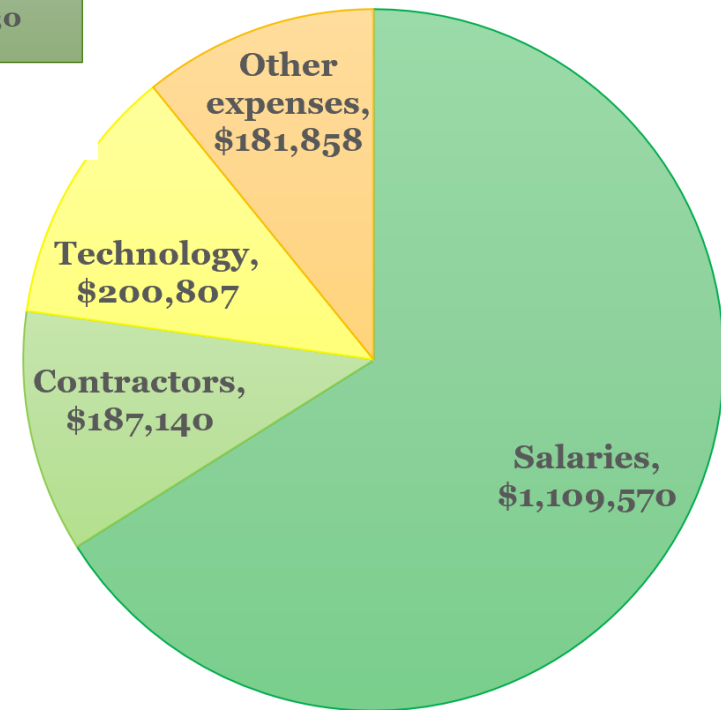
